Subject: Post Vasectomy Mode - Visual Input

Background: The POST VASECTOMY mode has the option to input manual data. When manual data is entered into the SQA-V, the system reports the manual data with a preference over the automated.

Update: There is a bug in the post vasectomy mode of the SQA-V. The bug appears when the user is required to input MANUAL data using the visual system. The screen below appears on the SQA-V for the manual input of # MOTILE SPERM and # IMMOTILE SPERM:


TURN FOCUS KNOB AND SCAN THROUGH ENTIRE CAPILLARY DEPTH TO COUNT MOTILE AND IMMOTILE SPERM

PLEASE ENTER:

MOTILE SPERM: #IMMOTILE SPERM:

If BOTH fields are not entered with a value (EVEN ZERO) and ENTER is pressed from the SQA-V keypad, the TOTAL NUMBER of SPERM will not be calculated on the test report (SEE BELOW).

FIX: Advise the customer to enter both the # MOTILE and the #IMMOTILE cells in the SQA-V fields even if the number is ZERO. Then press ENTER. The software will be updated with the next release to solve this problem.
